

Memorial Union Reinvestment Engagement and Involvement Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Who was involved in the Memorial Union Reinvestment?

A: As a membership organization and an area destination, the Wisconsin Union has engaged students, staff, faculty and members throughout this project.

Q: What role did public input play during the project?

A: Wisconsin Union members and the University of Wisconsin-Madison community served vital roles throughout the project, from conception to final design details.

Q: How many individuals were involved in the design process?More than 17,000 individuals provided input throughout the Memorial Union Reinvestment design process.

Q: How did the Wisconsin Union team collect project feedback?

A: The Wisconsin Union team collected feedback through 40 design workshops, 26 input sessions and open forums, four surveys and a dedicated project website. Memorial Union Reinvestment collaboration and input efforts have also included:

- Assembling a design committee that featured a student majority, along with faculty and staff
- Including a student project manager tasked with representing students

Q: Where can people learn about Memorial Union Reinvestment progress and provide project feedback?
